## Panola County Youth Diversion Plan For Justice of the Peace and Municipal Courts

## Youth Diversion Coordinator: Chief JPO Tracy Anderson

If child is eligible for diversion, coordinator will collect \$50 on case by case basis.

- The Justice of the Peace and Municipal Court will determine eligibility, complete the diversion agreement and Email the referral to Chief Juvenile Probation Officer Tracy Anderson – tanderson@co.panola.tx.us. Office #(903-693-0352)
- 2. An intake will be scheduled with youth and parent/guardian
- 3. At intake, the coordinator, youth and guardians will sign the diversion agreement and go over the program expectations, court orders and goals.
- 4. The program is up to 12 weeks. (possible extension)
- 5. Once the program is complete, the coordinator will submit completion certificate to the referring court. The case is then closed without further prosecution.
- 6. If the youth fails to participate or comply with the program expectations, the coordinator will return the referral to the sending court as unsuccessful.
- 7. If unsuccessful, the referring court could hold the youth in contempt and refer to the Juvenile Court to handle.
